²Small Fry lead-line walk trot

Small Fry classes are for children enrolled in Mini 4-H Horse & Pony, and that have completed the poster project (to be submitted during judging week). An adult family member must have the animal on a lead while in the show ring. A 4-H enrolled horse must be used—mini 4-Hers may not bring their own horse from home.

³Walk-Trot Classes

Horse/rider combination may not show in any other performance class in the same division, except Walk/Trot classes. Exhibitors competing in Walk-Trot classes in one division and in walk-trot-canter classes in a different division will not be eligible for all-around awards given at the year-end banquet. Walk Trot Equitation/Horsemanship—This class is for 4-Hers whose inexperience or disability prevents them from riding their animal at the canter or lope.

⁴Junior Western Pleasure- Animal 5 yrs and under

Class is based on age of animal; must be 5 years or younger. Rider may show in one other Western Pleasure class based on rider's age and size of animal; however, only ONE Western Pleasure class counts towards all-around points.

⁵Gaited/Saddle-Type Classes

If showing in Gaited/Saddle Type Western Pleasure, exhibitor may not show that horse in ANY other western pleasure class.

⁶Ranch Horse Pleasure

If showing in Ranch Horse Pleasure, NO other Western Pleasure Class may be entered.

If showing in beginner jumping, exhibitor may not show in any other jumping class. This class may count toward the walk-trot all-around award if exhibitor trots the crosspoles (no more than 2 canter strides).

⁹Hunter over Fences, Hunt Seat Equitation and Hunter Hack- Classes 70-72

Horse/rider combinations that do not pre-qualify may be required to successfully complete a graduated round prior to advancing to these classes, and may be disqualified/excused if judge deems advancement may be unsafe.

****High Point Awards-** Jr., Intermediate, and Sr. classes divisions

(1) Horse/ (1) Rider Combination

Will be given at the conclusion of each division (Western, English [including jumping], and Contesting).
