 - Record sheets are due to the extension office by 4:30pm. July 1st to complete project and show at fair. Leaders will sign tonight, and Stephanie can turn in for you if you would like.
 - Stall request forms are due to the extension office by July 1st.
 - Mini 4-Hers must be enrolled in mini to show at the county fair.
 - They must show an animal that is already at the fairgrounds—no bringing your own animal.
 - A family member 18 or older must be the handler for the horse.
 - You must still complete the poster project and turn in at mini judging on July 12 to show a horse.
 - There is a waiver/form that must be turned in with the poster in order to show. See the extension office with questions.
 - Due to recent events at other fairgrounds, it is highly recommended that you keep your tack and supplies locked in trailers during fair. Do not leave valuables out overnight.
- Rules Review:
 - Make sure you have a handbook--look at rules BEFORE fair to make sure you don't get disqualified from a class. The leaders/judges will follow all printed rules in handbooks.
